One approach involves buildings that cover their total energy consumption with <u>renewable</u> energy sources. One innovative example is the ZCB (Zero Carbon Building) located in Hong Kong. As one might expect, their main energy sources are photovoltaic panels and biofuel. But who would have guessed that the biofuel used is made of waste cooking oil produced in Hong Kong, China? Even their lift regenerates energy when braking and, under certain conditions, when moving up or down. And this is just a very small selection of the features they have applied to achieve the goal of zero net carbon emissions.

Another problem that is already being addressed is the rising demand for food in combination with a shortage of (agricultural) land. The solution here is "Vertical Farming," which is based on farms that grow upwards instead of outwards. Today's largest vertical farm is located in Michigan, the USA and is home to 17 million plants.

Growing traffic problems are another issue that needs to be resolved in the future. In this context Saffa Riffat et al. mention technologies such as self-driving vehicles, electric vehicles, and more exotic approaches including the Aero-Mobil flying car and the Aero-Train, which is train and plane in one.
